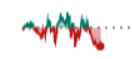



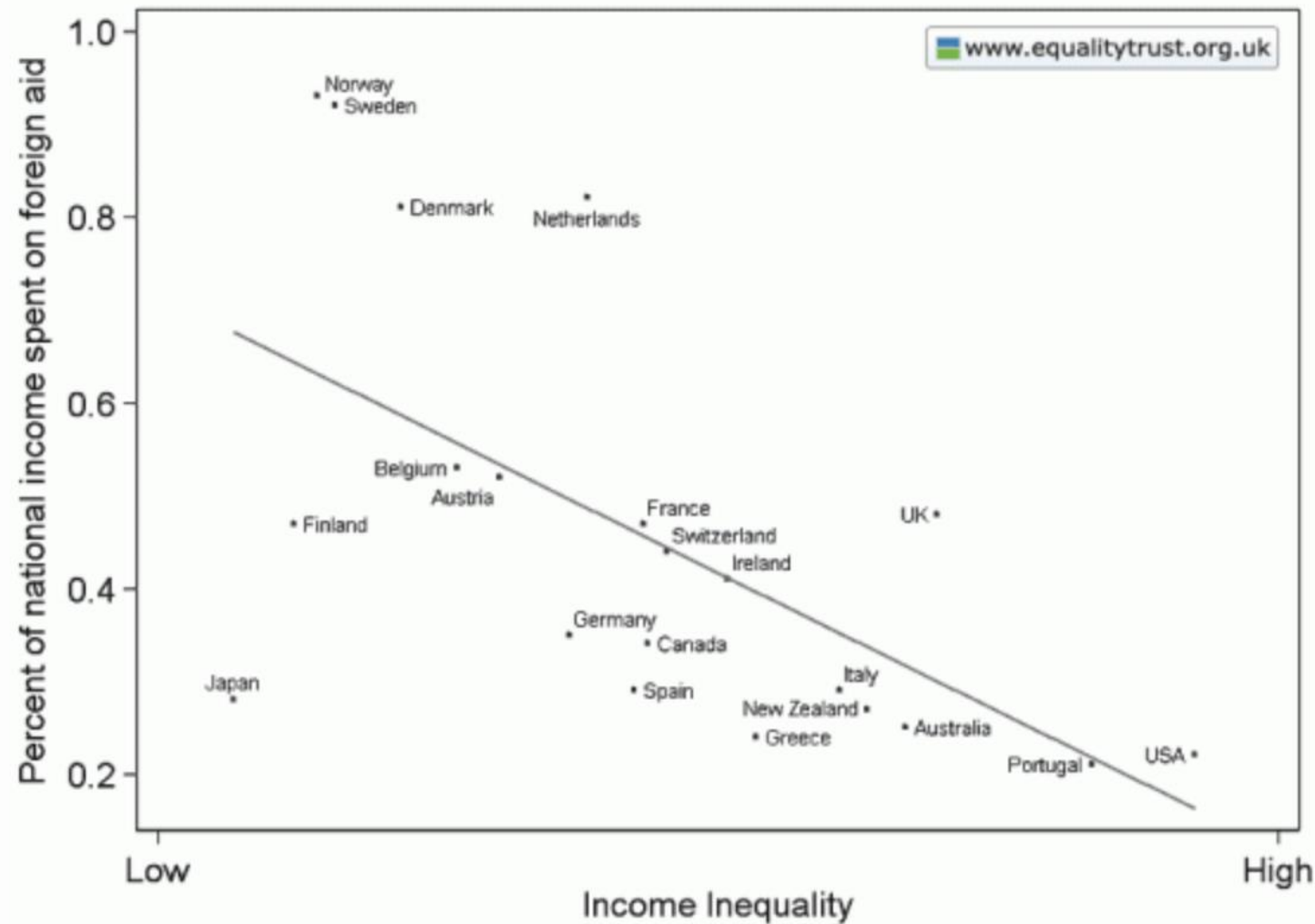

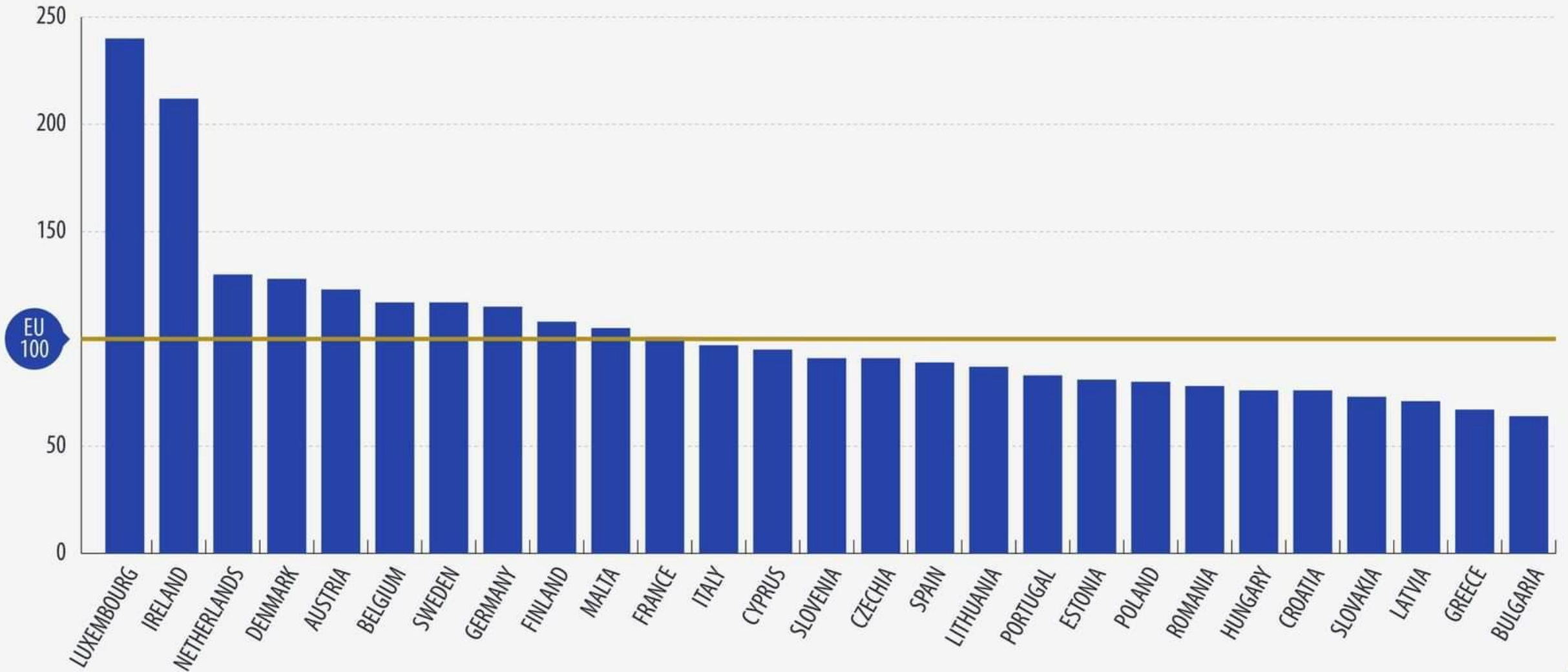
More equal societies spend a higher proportion their income on overseas aid and perform better on the Global Peace Index.

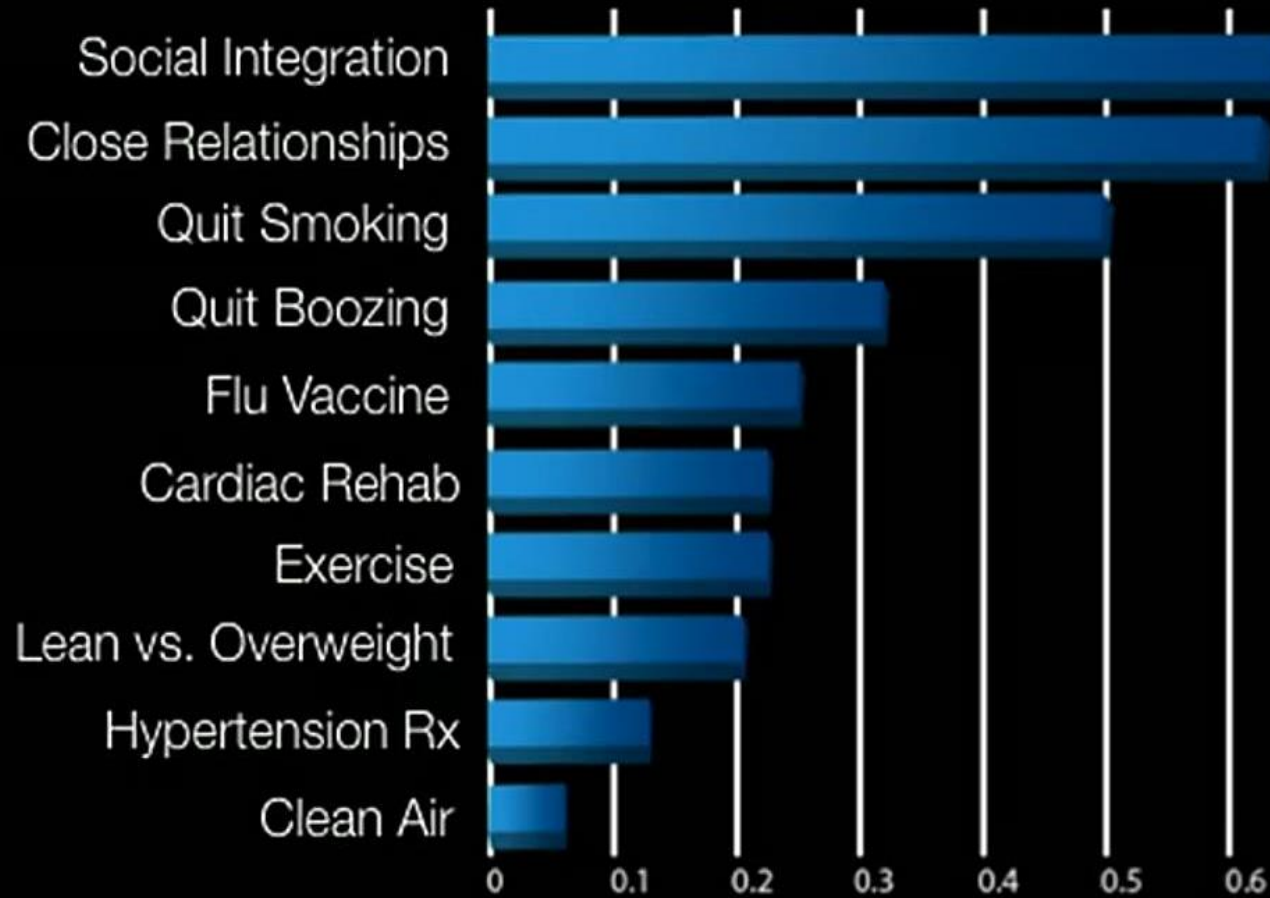
